TO REGISTER TO VOTE

Who: A U.S. citizen, legal resident of Washington State, at least 18 years old by Election Day, not disqualified from voting due to a court order, and not under Department of Corrections supervision for a Washington felony conviction.

When: 29 days before an election. If you register by mail, it must be postmarked by the cutoff date. You can register in person at the county elections department until 8 days before the election.

How: Complete and mail in a voter registration form. You will need a Washington State driver's license, Washington State ID card, or Social Security number. If you do not have one of these, contact the elections department.

If you are new to the county, have moved within the county, or have questions, contact the Cowlitz County Elections Department: 207 N. 4th Ave, Room 107, Kelso, WA, 98626, (360) 577-3005, Fax (360) 442-7879, or www.vote.wa.gov/cowlitz.

There is no registration by political party in Washington.
